

Mallet Parking Instruction

The Mallet RV Park has a different design than most RV Parks across Texas. Our RV Park is not a Pull-Through park like most.

To park in the Mallet RV Park, a trailer/RV must be able to back up behind another trailer leaving them back end to back end. If the following parking instructions are followed correctly, there will be enough room between the trailers to access any doors of the trailer/RV without problems. There should be approximately 6' to 10' between the trailers/RVs.

If a trailer/RV is parked incorrectly, it will have to be moved immediately to accommodate other visitors.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARKING IN RV SPACES:

ALL EVEN NUMBER RV SPACES:

Park with nose of trailer facing WEST (away from building). Back doors of trailer/RV should be even and NOT BEHIND the water faucets. Please pull forward enough to ensure odd RV spaces will have enough room to park also.

Another indication you have parked correctly is your Trailer/RV break lights will be even with the concrete slab which your water faucet sits.

Do not park with the Electric, Water, Sewer pedestals beside your trailer/RV.

ALL ODD NUMBER RV SPACES:

Park with nose of trailer facing EAST (toward building). Back doors of trailer/RV should be even but NOT BEHIND the Electrical Box. Please pull forward enough to ensure even RV spaces will have enough room to park also.

Another indication you have parked correctly is your Trailer/RV break lights will be even with the concrete slab which your electrical box sits.

Do not park with the Electric, Water, Sewer pedestals beside your trailer/RV.
